

LEVEL 3/6: SUPERVISING FIRST TRAINING AID FOR MENTAL HEALTH

Duration

The qualification has 6 assigned guided learning hours (GLH) and 14 hours total qualification time (TQT). GLH indicates the number of contact hours that the learner will have with the trainer/assessor. TQT includes GLH but considers unsupervised learning and is an estimate of how long the average learner will take to achieve the qualification. It is beneficial for the learner to undertake additional independent learning for example, by doing research on the internet.

Syllabus

A range of First Aid for Mental Health related subjects are covered including:

- Identifying mental health conditions Self-harm
- Providing advice and starting a conversation
 Suicide
- Stress Eating disorders
- Mental health conditions

- First Aid for Mental Health in the workplace Schizophrenia
- Depression Anxiety

Numbers

A maximum of 16 students are allowed on the course and must be a minimum of 16 years of age. A certificate can be offered to all, subject to assessment.

Assessment

A range of methods are used, including practical and questioning (open and multiple-choice).

Certification

The qualification is valid for three years from the date of achievement. It is strongly recommended that the learner attends annual refresher training. The learner will need to complete the full course again to requalify for a further three years.
